Getting Started

First you need to find which method you will need to fill your needs. There are two main ways: Tumbling and bin composting. Tumbling needs a tumbling composer and is the fastest way to compost. Bin composting is cheaper to install, but takes longer to compost. Bin composting also requires stirring, where as the tumbler you just spin the barrel.

What to Put in It

Use things that were once plants. Lawn Waste is good but avoid using twigs or sticks. Kitchen scraps are good too. Stay away from bread because it tends to mold. Also meat is a big no-no. Newspaper can be used to as long as it is shredded.
